OPEN STUDIOS : SARAH BUTTERS

It is a great pleasure to be able to welcome Sarah Butters back to the Festival for the 2020 online Open Studios. Sarah took part in a year-long Wool Residency at the farm in association with the Spring Festival. This was to offered to support her research into the processing and dyeing of wool as part of her professional artistic development – but also to investigate the potential uses of wool produced at White House Farm and to advise on the creation of a natural dye garden.

In 2019 Sarah curated a solo show Land | Plants | Fibre as part of our inaugural Plomesgate Fair. It has been fascinating to see the depth and breadth of her research and artistic work expand. One of her most recent creations, No 15 a hand spun, knitted and crocheted wool/silk panel is mesmerizingly beautiful and reminiscent of Anni Albers designs for woven panels. All Sarah's work is deeply rooted in her surroundings. The yarn is spun from the wool of individual flocks (sometimes a known sheep), dyed with natural pigments she makes and knitted or felted or crocheted by hand with the occasional use of ethically sourced silk.

MAKER'S STATEMENT

One off and bespoke wool work made with natural fibres and plant dyes. All pieces are of this land in Suffolk, UK with the addition of silk from China and India. From the sheep's back to finished product : hand spun yarn, hand knits, felt and peg loom weaving. Wearable art, sculptural objects, yarn, hand mande drop spindles and crochet hooks. In making all these, my attention is drawn to process -based work that carries within it stories of intimate connection to the natural world.
